Requirements for scientific abstracts:

All articles presented for publication must contain scientific novelty and practical significance. Abstracts should be limited to 1 page and presented in Microsoft Word for Windows (.doc, .docx), portrait orientation, A4 page format, Times New Roman font, size 12, sesquialteral line spacing, width alignment, without page numbers, all margins: 20 mm., no line-breaks.

The abstract's structure:

The first line should contain the name of the author and his or her academic degree; the next line – institution, city, country, author's e-mail; the third line – the abstract's title in capital letters. The abstract's contents should include the purpose of research, its results and conclusions. Abstracts should not include tables, figures, graphs and references.

See below the sample of an abstract's structure (Appendix 1).

Please, pay attention, that all articles are published "as it is" without additional editing. The organizing committee reserves the right to decline materials from including into the printed Collected Papers.

Publication of full research papers in Scopus-indexed editions

Dear colleagues! The organizing committee is offering the opportunity to publish your full-text research paper in the collection of papers of the conference, which will be indexed in Scopus bibliographic and abstract database. The volume of the paper is 6 pages or less (A4 format, font size 10, single spacing) excluding References. Please, send your full-text papers to ecobio@dalgau.ru marking them as "Scopus Paper" by June 1, 2020.
